## Just Foolin' Around By JOHN TAYLOR, SR.

Webster's 1828 Dictionary defines **foolishness**, in part, as: *Void of understanding or sound judgment; silly; vain; trifling; unwise; imprudent; acting without judgment* or discretion. The antonym of foolish is wise.

It seems that foolish children have become the norm in our society. Parents or guardians excuse silliness by saying, "They're just kids; they'll grow out of it." So they are allowed to be fools until it seems to be the accepted norm.

fool · ish \'fü-lish\ adjective

Our culture is fabricated to cultivate foolishness. Kids play video games, watch movies, listen to music produced by fools, "chill out" with their friends, and just sit around the house doing nothing until the next pleasure is available. Then, when the time comes for them to sit still and pay attention in a church, they act goofy and can't be still because they aren't being entertained. There are some fun things that will contribute to a boy's normal male development, but nearly all packaged entertainment is designed by fools for fools. They don't teach boys to be men.

Most boys today have one common problem, just one—lack of association with a strong father. Having a strong father but not associating with him is the same as not having a strong father. Boys need to be harnessed with men of character if they are going to grow up to be wise.

When I was a boy growing up (I was the only son in our family), I worked right beside my daddy. I am sure that, like every little kid, at first I was a burden and slowed him down, but my skills grew until I knew I was needed. He would always say, "Ain't no boy of mine gonna be a sissy." So we worked hard, wrestled hard, and played not so hard. When I would have been silly, my daddy was there setting the tone, and somehow silliness was always inappropriate. He was the main influence in my life, not the video games, sport figures, or movie stars. I was never left to myself to develop apart from him. My dad, to a point, was my life. But as I grew older, I came to understand that the things he required of me were for my benefit.

We as fathers have a huge responsibility to teach our sons to be sober minded. "Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded" (Titus 2:6). Foolishness is part of depravity and will come naturally if children are left to themselves. "Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child" (Proverbs 22:15). That means you have to be there and be a part of their life all the time. Just as a tree cannot mature and bear fruit without the proper nourishment from the soil, sons cannot mature and bear fruit without our time and training. Around the ages of 12-16 years old they start to change. It is imperative that we have laid a wise foundation by that stage in their lives or the fool will emerge and dominate their lives.

I am now 36 years old and have been married almost 18 years. I have 7 children and I still talk to my dad about some of the decisions I make. He doesn't make them for me anymore, but I value what he thinks. You won't instill that in your sons if you have not been the major player in their lives. You had better get their heart while they're young.



# Silly Boys BY MICHAEL PEARL

Perpetually silly boys are an embarrassment to their fathers and a shame to their mothers; moreover, they are the public proof of a father's neglect and a mother's indulgence.

silly boy is disgusting and repulsive, because he is the antithesis of all that is attractive in a male. There is no age at which silliness is normal. It is in all circumstances inappropriate. How many times have you heard people say it, "Don't be silly"? All of my readers could mimic the tone at which it is always uttered—a hurried, dismissive, embarrassment, carrying a presumption that it is out of place and most unbecoming.

Almost every boy will get silly from time to time. Mine did. Thankfully, it was passing, and not characteristic of them as a whole. But there are some boys who retreat behind a clown's mask of silliness. They adopt it as the persona of their social self. The sillier they are, the more they are rejected, and with further rejection comes more silliness, a make-believe world where all is laughter and irresponsible indulgence. Their fool's paradise is a retreat where no demand can be placed upon them and where they can take the stage as somebody else, hoping to get a laugh or at least create one for themselves. Silliness is a wall against transparency, a rejection of responsibility, and a denial of accountability. It is a drug, a high, a continuous party mentality, a thoughtless denial of tomorrow.

I was in grade school in the fifties and started high school in 1959. I don't remember any really silly boys, not like today's crowd of them. The average church in America has a parade of silly fools. Public schools must be giving the boys silly pills.

So, if your son is generally silly, what can you do to make a man of him? Start by killing his role models. Hollywood schools the kids into silliness with their goofy entertainment. I don't know the names of some of the characters I have briefly seen, but as I sit here, I recall a ridiculous grinning fool, dressed in flowery clothes, showing overly large teeth and gums, with a slobbery way of talking, making contorted faces and dancing around giggling like he had just had his brain replaced with bubble gum. I have never viewed anything with him in it, but I have caught a glimpse of him on several occasions, and he is always accompanied by several big-busted babes who must have failed the second grade and decided not to pursue any higher education. These are the idols of our present generation. Commercials, movies, radio and TV program-

ming represent men as blundering fools and women as wise and in control.

In my youth, Tarzan, Roy Rogers, and Gene Autry were the entertainment models of maleness. I watched them and went outside to swing on a vine, shoot a BB gun, throw a knife, and dare the bad guys to molest the fair maidens; they would have to answer to me. Today, after kids watch the

media, whatever sort it may be, they go to the mall to play the fool. If you allow your boys to be exposed to "funny" fools—fools that you find entertaining—how can you expect them to be any different?

Parents don't seem to know what the advertisers know—"monkey see, monkey do". Companies pay millions of dollars to display a role model on the screen drinking their brand or wearing their shoes. If kids are not influenced by what they see on the screen, the advertisers are spending billions of dollars foolishly. Morals are continually being eroded, and the sacred is becoming profane on the digital screen. Hollywood injects their philosophy into the fiber optic catheter at their end, and **you** insert the digital needle into the veins of your children on your end every time you let them watch a perverse Hollywood flick, G-rated or not. Their hearts and minds are

receiving daily infusions directly from the veins of queers, fornicators, atheists, evolutionists, and irreverent fools.

But media is not the only fountain of foolishness. Understand that it takes a certain context to be silly. When two friends encourage each other in stupidity, separate them until they mature. But you can't save your child from being a fool just by preventing bad company. Put a boy in a man's world and his foolishness will go the way of baby talk and wet diapers. Daddy and his friends will respond to foolishness like they would a cat licking its XXX. Try that nonsense in their presence and no one will be entertained. They will look at the kid like "What's his problem?" and then return to their conversation. The cold critical looks of three men will do more to slap the sillies out of a kid than all the lectures in the world.

Silliness can only exist in a responsibility vacuum. A man (or boy) who is given responsibilities and is committed to performing his duty will never be silly. Where there is self-respect, there will be sobriety and dignity. When a kid knows he is valued for his participation in life's duties, he will respect himself too much to play the fool. The boy who feels worthless is the one who seeks attention by opening his mouth wide like a toilet seat to display his chewed food. The kid who sits in church during communion and gets another kid's attention by pretending to choke on the bread is one who has

no real life of any consequence. He is disconnected from reality. To him, nothing is serious because nothing is real. He is not a real or active part of society. He is on the outside making faces through the window. One must contribute to be a member, and only members have responsibilities. An irresponsible child has been left out of life. He has been set aside like a bothersome child rather than made an apprentice to manhood.

A hungry child is never silly. A child in pain is sober. A child who just stacked a cord of fire wood is as serious as a veteran home from the war. A man and a boy walking out of the woods together carrying the game "they" bagged are a fellowship of men. A six-year-old boy who just tightened the screws on the doorknob again is grave and manly. He walks straight and would not demean himself by acting the fool. A boy who is talked to, but not talked down to, will maintain a social presence that earns him the right to adult conversation.

A child who respects other people will not play the court jester at inappropriate times. Our worldviews are mirrored in our demeanors. A silly kid is revealing his lack of regard for what other people think is worthy of sobriety. You will gain a child's respect and thus create in him a reason to maintain his dignity in your presence by being interested in him as a person and sharing your life and work with him. Build camaraderie with him and you cause the kid to adopt your perspective, invalidating useless silliness which doesn't get him the kind of attention he now values from the people whom he values. Silliness fills a vacuum in a boy's soul. Don't allow that vacuum to exist.

I began by saying that silly boys are public proof of a father's neglect and of a mother's indulgence. I have addressed the father's responsibility. Now, please sit down, mothers.

When a son is over-indulged by his mother, and criticized by his sisters, he will be silly. Pay attention. A boy, at any age, is an incomplete man, with all the ego of a man. God designed man for a purpose. If he is deprived of opportunity to fulfill his natural role, he will be self-loathing—which is self-love turned on itself. If mother keeps her son close to her bosom, not allowing him to be a man, perhaps expecting him to be more like the girls in temperament, he will not be fulfilled as a human being and will express his self-disgust by acting in many disgusting ways.

It is often the case that a father is distant to his son, or the father is critical and rejects the boy. Perhaps he is disgusted with the silliness and girlishness of the kid. Mother sees her son's hurt and draws him to her love, heaping positive affirmation on his wounds. He willingly comes for reassurance, but he will not be fulfilled as a man. His silliness will eventually turn to foolishness. Mother, release your son from your emotional guard. Let him walk or fall as may be. Give him responsibilities, and do not pity him. The frame of mind that you must adopt is that you are going to work yourself out of a job as soon as possible. Your job is to harden him up and make him tough, and then to release him back to the wild to fend for himself. By puberty, you must have transferred much of the command to your son. The man you get back will be far more satisfying to you as a mother than the boy you attempted to preserve.

Silliness can pass with maturity, but if it becomes chronic in the five- to ten-year-old boys, it turns to foolishness. A fool is one who lives without a consciousness of reality. He lacks understanding and imagines the world to be without rules or consequences. Nothing is sacred. He is

unaware of danger. He doesn't prepare for tomorrow, yet he won't deny himself any pleasure. The fool will talk as if he is an authority on a subject of which he knows nothing. Fools make a mockery of sin and brush off warnings.

Here is a study you can do with your young children, boys and girls together. Get a Strong's complete concordance and locate the 115 times that the word "fool" appears

in the Bible—King James Version. Read all 115 passages with your children, allowing them to give their interpretation of each one. Do five every school day, and it will take you one month to go through them all. I guarantee you that you will see a difference in your children. The fool will be worked out of them through the word of God.

If you are a fatherless household, there are two things you can do. Find a worthy man who will allow your son to work with him, even one time a week. You will know he is a worthy man if his grown children rise up and call him blessed and they exemplify what you want your son to become. Secondly, provide contexts and circumstances for your son to succeed—at anything. Encourage him in different endeavors until several things stick. A kid that plays musical instruments should also take martial arts or archery. I have never seen a silly boy who was also good at throwing knives and hatchets, carpentry, mechanics, or lawn care. It is rare indeed to see a hardworking kid act silly.

Responsibility and fellowship are the two key words. If you see to it that your young men identify with serious people, they will be serious. If they develop a will to suffer the pain of work, they will never suffer from silliness. You can do it, mother. It won't be any harder for you, a single mother, than it is for the lady whose husband is emotionally absent or is abusive to the children. If there is no man in the family, make one of your son by the time he is eight years old, and you will have a male presence and perspective in the home that both you and he can recognize.



Then my daughter who is three years old spoke up and said, "I did too." So I asked her, "Why did you do that?" She answered, "Because Bubba did." Then I asked my son why he ate dog food, and he said, "I just wanted to see what it tasted like."

When I began to tell him about how he as the older brother needed to be more mindful of what he's doing because it will/can influence his younger brothers and sisters, he just laughed and thought it was funny. He took my admonition very lightly, pretty much ignoring what I was saying. He then proceeded to say how he wanted to eat more dog food.

Where had my wise son gone? I set out to find him again. So I set him up for a fall. "You do?" I asked, "Don't you think that's pretty silly, seeing that your mother fixes us good food, and here you are wanting to eat dog food?" While I was talking, he got up from the table, still giggling, then went over and got a handful of dog food and commenced eating it. I have to admit, at this point, I was genuinely disgusted, both at his silliness and at the thought of him eating dog food. My face must have reflected my feelings, because he just laughed and said in a challenging way, "Whaaat?" As if it was no big deal, and like he seriously enjoyed eating the dog food.

This was getting gross, besides the fact that my sober son was acting like a goofy nincompoop. I stopped right there with dinner and told him that since he thought it was so funny to eat dog food and since he seemed to enjoy it so much, he had to give the dog his food and he could not have anything else for dinner or breakfast but dog food. We had a fine dinner. My wife can out-cook any woman alive. He is a growing boy with a BIG appetite.

Oh, he tried to play it off, but the gravity of the consequence for his foolishness began to set in after about two minutes of wallowing the dry, gritty stuff around in his mouth, until he had to spit it out. His countenance changed, his giggling stopped and his foolishness was over. He had repented. He was hungry, but our deal was binding. He stayed hungry until the next day. I got my sober son back.

#### **Tremaine Responds**

Simple occasions like this can become defining moments...establishing what a boy is becoming. Each foolish happening must be considered and brought under control either by constrained consequences or by the rod.

I'm sure there isn't a child out there who hasn't done something equally as foolish at least once. Most parents are not weeding out foolishness like this wise dad, but are allowing it to continue, thinking it must just be just a passing stage. Discounting all the early signs, parents are shocked and surprised when their children grow up to be teenage fools. The Bible says, "...a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame" (Proverbs 29:15). It is truly embarrassing to see your children acting like fools.

**Proverbs 17:21** He that begetteth a fool doeth it to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no joy.

**Proverbs 17:25** A foolish son is a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him.

**Proverbs 19:13** A foolish son is the calamity of his father...

**Proverbs 10:1**...a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother.

God instructed us to teach our children sobriety.

There is a difference between childishness and foolishness. Paul said in 1 Corinthians 13:1, "When I was a child I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child." Childishness is immaturity, but it should not include "acting" the silly fool. Don't pass over foolishness as a child-like behavior.

So then, where does foolishness come from? The Bible says in Proverbs 22:15, "Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him." Foolishness is pure silliness (in word or actions). Fools are born, but a wise, sober son is carefully cultivated.

What can a parent do? At the first foolish word or deed, bring it to their attention; tell them how silly it is, and express your displeasure in proportion to the act and situation. Arrange a consequence for every foolish thing they do, while exhorting them to be sober minded (to think soberly). Show them with your own life how we should live soberly. Hold each child accountable according to their level of maturity.

"Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul" (Pr 29:17).

If your son is already foolish, how do you fix the problem? The Bible clearly tells us what action(s) we must take if we are going to produce wise and sober children.

- Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.
- Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom ...
- **Proverbs 20:30** The blueness of a wound cleanseth away evil: so do stripes the inward parts of the belly.
- **Proverbs 19:18** Chasten thy son while there is hope, and let not thy soul spare for his crying.
- **Proverbs 23:13** Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die. (14) Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell.

As parents whose intent is to bring our children up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, out of love we won't spare the rod, but we do understand that "no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby" (Hebrews 12:11).

**Ephesians 6:4** And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

**Proverbs 13:24** He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.

"They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing" Psalm 92:14

They say some people get depressed after a heart attack. I didn't. My life is too full of friends, kids, and happy, growing grandkids to get discouraged. I have enough good memories to last me through a thousand years of slowdown, and am making more memories everyday. This past Sunday, one of my grandsons, Jeremiah, 30 months young, came into the church service at the last minute after everyone was seated. He hurriedly marched up to the front where I was sitting and planted himself right in front of me. While jabbering something I couldn't understand he reached down, grabbed his

pants, and pushed them to the floor, then he leaned back and jerked his shirt up, proudly showing me his new underwear with the blue and red thing-a-ma-giggles printed on it. He was grinning with delight and satisfaction as he babbled his

joy at the display of his Sunday attire. It brought him and everyone else such pleasure, I am going to see if I can find a pair in size 38. The church won't get to see mine, but when Jeremiah and I go swimming in the creek, we will look alike.

I have been working outdoors, building a new house on our property up on a high hill. It doesn't have any 90° corners. I designed it around multiple octagons. It is totally unconventional, with an indoor swimming pool and greenhouse combination. I cut all the timber off the farm and milled it on a sawmill that I built for that purpose. I have a huge stack of nine by five red oak beams drying. It will be post and beam construction with lots of poured concrete and local rock. The floors will be eight to twelve inch wide oak boards that I cut. The full basement will be left open for the grandkids to roller skate, and the pool will have rope swings and a rock climbing wall, complete with a waterfall and lots of live plants. It sounds expensive, but I will build the whole thing for less than \$80,000.00. I have been working on it for four years, here a little, there a little, as I get the money and time. Since my heart attack, I have been taking the doctor's orders and spending more time away from the office, working by myself or with one of my sons-in-law. Sometimes the grandkids think they are helping me.



When I get it finished, I will let you fly over and take an aerial photograph. At the rate I am working it will probably take me another three or four years to finish it, but it is not the finishing I need, but the building of it. I am back to preaching in the prisons and teaching here in church. I am writing three new books at once. Sometimes I work on one and then on another.

Finally, don't believe everything you read about heart disease. I am as far from impotence as I was at 25. Some things never quit or even slow down. Well, not much.

The staff of 15 here at NGJ is moving forward as never before. Exciting things are happening and the ministry continues to grow. I am thankful to have dedicated workers who have a heart for the ministry. Through the piloting of Mel Cohen, our General Manager, we have spread out into an international ministry. It gets busier around here every day. Pray for us. The wolves are circling and the stray dogs are howling, but we turn a deaf ear to them and charge ahead with all joy.



#### LITTLE MEN

Dear Pearls,

We adopted a child when he was just a baby. We now have several younger birth children. Our whole family enjoys camping and fishing except our oldest. He only likes sports. We have never had a TV or joined in games of this kind, but he will find a way to watch or play any chance he has, even to the point of lying. This causes an extreme breach between us. I have trouble forgiving him. What can we do to get him on the family team? How do we deal with a child who doesn't want to be a part?

#### **DEBI'S COMMON SENSE (WITH A LITTLE EDITING BY MIKE)**

You want him to be a part of your team but you do not want to be part of his. You are assuming that talent and interest can be dictated—a grave mistake. YOU are the one making it an "adoption" problem. When you love someone, you want to see them fulfilled as a person—as the person they are, not the person you want them to be.

You cannot, and should not, replace a person's dreams with your own goals and desires. If you like hunting or sports or mechanics, that is your heart, and it is fine for you, but if your son likes something different, you are the one who needs to sacrifice to aid him in the fulfillment of his dreams.

If you have read *Created To Be His Help Meet*, you know about the 3 kinds of men. Like God is three, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, man was created in God's IM-AGE. Some men are Command men, some Steady, and some Visionary. Well, boys are little men. If you happen to have a Visionary, then you can be sure he will not be interested in sports or fishing. When you go fishing, he will be interested in building a dam to change the watercourse. If you take him to a sports game, he will be more interested in coming up with a new way to play the game. Boys need to grow up to be the men they were born to be. Help them be the best at WHO THEY ARE.

I detect that you think there is some vanity or evil in your son's interest. You are too religious even for God. Concentrate on building character in whatever pursuit your son chooses. It is wise to make available many options that are constructive and character building, but don't think that in the end you can dictate interests. Buy yourself a baseball glove or soccer ball and take him to play. Stand by and cheer like it was the most exciting thing in the world. It is the only way you are going to win.

#### CHAPLAIN ASKS

Dear brethren of NGJ,

You recently sent us 2 cases of *Good & Evil* in Spanish. We thank you. We are in the process of distributing these to the Hispanic Catholics in the two higher aggression cell-houses.

Let me update you to a new ministry door at the prison. We have five cell houses, plus a medium security unit housing 400 men. Our population at this time is a little over 3500. Thus far, the *Good & Evil* books donated to us have been almost exclusively devoted to "seeding" the Segregation cell house. Here, those inmates who have behaved violently or aggressively within the prison itself are housed. As described previously, all privileges are removed. They are without TV or radio. Many find themselves behind solid steel doors. It creates a desperate desire for "anything" to read. Thus, when we offer one of the *Good & Evil* books, almost without exception they are eagerly accepted.

Multiple numbers of testimonies of conversions have come specifically attributed to these books. But please note that we have only placed them in one of five cell houses.

The new ministry door is that my fellow chaplain will be focusing for the first time on getting into the galleries of the largest of the cell houses. Approximately 750 men are housed there. While these are not categorized as high in aggression as the other two previously named, this cell house is not as "receptive" as the Segregation cell house. The conditions of living in it are not "as bad".

Our prayer is that a sufficient number of books can be donated to allow

O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is.

**PSALM 63:1** 

Chaplain Harner to aggressively hand them out in this cell house. A conservative estimate is that we could distribute 700 plus in two to three months.

There is another element of this harvest field. As one of three maximum security prisons in Illinois, and one of three processing prisons for new prisoners and those being "shuffled around", we see a high turnover of inmates to us and from us.

Thus, over time the placement of

these *Good & Evil* books in the hands of hundreds of Inmates will result in the books turning up in prisons across the state! When you envision 3500 men at Menard, realize that monthly we shuffle many from us to other prisons and receive new inmates constantly. The harvest field here is not static.

We know this is a large request. But the field white unto harvest before us is both very visible and massive. The donations that have come from and through you have thus far impacted one cell house of 670+ men. We are now ready to cast gospel seed in another cell house if the LORD deems fit to provide at this time.

Humbly, we lay this before you and will be praying the LORD of the harvest to provide according to His purposes and timing. Thank you for your partnership in the Gospel.

~ Blessed be God for Christ, His Crown & Covenant, Pastor/Chaplains Claycomb & Harner On behalf of the inmate population here at the Charles Egeler Reception and Guidance Center, I thank you and appreciate the help that your ministry has given us. The inmates enjoy the literature very much.

Here at this facility, all inmates who are committed by the Department of Corrections are processed and then forwarded to a more permanent facility. The time spent here is a period of great adjustment and soul searching for most men. (Current number of inmates: 1,850)

With the amount of men processed daily, the materials are being put to great use here by the men in a number of ways. Again, I thank you for your willingness to contribute, and on behalf of all the men houses at this facility, may God continue to richly bless you. – Sincerely, Isa Abdul Basir/Chaplain

No, these wicked men do not deserve the gift of salvation, just as you and I don't deserve God's love, but that is the whole point. God deserves to be glorified in the saving of great sinners. Jesus went to ultimate lengths to purchase forgiveness for us sinners; to what lengths should we go to make his love gift known to sinners?

In Luke 8, we read the parable of the sower. "And the sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it. And some fell upon a

Now, with your help, we are sowing all over the world. To date, we have sent Good and Evil out to about 1,000 prisons in the USA.

You may have heard that I don't have much time for drop-in visitors from our readership, and that's true, but it is not due to my being antisocial. I have had as many as three ex-prisoners visiting here at one time. Furthermore, if you did come to visit, when you stopped by a neighbor's house to ask directions, they would think you were just another one of those "saved guys from the prison." I never turn away a former inmate who has come to know the Lord. They have my full attention. If you have ever received anything from NGJ, know that it was packed by a convicted murderer whom I ministered to for six years before he was released. He walks in truth. He now ministers the gospel in several state or city facilities. You can hear his testimony or hear him preach the Word on our free PODCAST found on the front page of our website. He is just one of many.

So, who were the lady and little daughter left unmolested this week because another sinner repented toward God? Maybe it was you and yours.

You can take books to your local jail, prison, or juvenile detention center. We will sell them to you at our cost of operation if you are giving them to inmates. Of all our

ministries, the prison outreach is the one where we get the most requests for free books and the least amount of gifts to pay for them. We are not asking you to keep this ministry afloat and pay our salaries. That is taken care of in the sales of our materials. But we cannot supply each of the 2.5 million inmates in the USA with the *Good and Evil* books without your help. 16

"Jesus loves you, brother."


He walked off. I could swear he said, "Crazy \*\*\* white boy..."

We have sent him \$1200.00 worth of books. Someone's donation will pay for them, souls will be saved, and the donor will receive the reward in eternity.



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

I was 20 years old, sitting in a prison cell, when the Word of God brought me to repentance. It won't be so with my children.

One of the great mistakes of Christian parents is thinking their small children are too young to receive knowledge and understand doctrine. God doesn't make that mistake. The Bible says, "Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he

make to understand doctrine? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts" (Isaiah 28:9). Most Christian parents think that the Bible is too R-rated for their children, so they used Bible storybooks that are purged of sin, fire, judgment, and the wrath of God. No one would fear the God depicted in these stories. Children will commit vile acts while

being quite familiar with these sanitized stories, seeing no connection between the Bible message and their sin. The "sweet" Bible stories of Jesus feeding the 5,000 and walking on the water don't have application to the real world. When some other kid approaches your four-year-old with a thrilling opportunity to fulfill elicit curiosity, and your child doesn't immediately fear God and the consequences of sin, you have miserably failed as the spiritual mentor of your child. Bible teaching stripped of its harsh realities in order to make it inoffensive to children also makes it ineffective in combating sin.

I have taught my son the Word of God long before I thought he would need to be armed against sin. I don't want him to go into battle with an unloaded gun. Instead of bringing us shame or grief, our son has brought to us great joy. I am proud of the boy he is, and am looking forward to the man I will help him become.

I told you he listens to Mike's sermons every night and has learned much, but I must offer one caution. He has also listened many time to Mrs. Debi's *My Favorite Homeschool* CD. He often quotes her when he doesn't want to go through long hours of curriculum. I remind him that Mrs. Debi doesn't know everything, so just do your work.

She is very active and has a difficult time sitting still for any time at all. I think the impatient professionals would dub her "hyperactive".

I do not want to make learning a burden to her, so I try to think of creative ways to make it delightful play. Most recently, while my husband was away on a business trip, I told Gracie, "Let's make Daddy a card." We were both excited



about this idea, so for the next two hours Gracie was completely engrossed in copying and sounding out letters and drawing pictures. She was learning but without even knowing she was learning. We both had a great time doing our Daddy Project. More importantly, I had learned more about my child and how to keep her engaged in learning.

Everyone needs some kind of motivation to force themselves to learn new things. The younger the child, the more immediate the reward needs to be. Telling a three-year-old that when she is twenty, she will want to know how to write and read is not going to work. Writing a card for Daddy who is expected home any day was enough motivation to cause her to enjoy the challenge of learning and writing. It is a great experience teaching my little girl to love to read. I look forward daily to us learning together. If I do it right, she will never dread learning, but will value it as a thrilling adventure. I know it is for me.

woman. I joined corporate America in the hospitality industry, had a good position, and was making good money. To put it truthfully, I was miserable! Since I was in 4th grade, I wanted to be a homemaker, taking great care of my husband and children. I knew what it looked like but I did not know how to obtain it.

My husband and I reconciled and gave it another try. Now that I had been out in his world of backstabbing and water cooler talk, I came to understand his need for an understanding wife and peaceful home. Try as we might, we celebrated our 10th wedding anniversary in hopes of a new beginning. It wasn't too long before we were both not feeling as hopeful for our situation.

To make a long story short, a friend of mine moved to Louisiana with her husband as he went to pastor a small church there. My friend, being a big northern city girl shocked the southern women with her openness. It wasn't long before a wise lady that had befriended her gave her a book. ### **Our Worldwide Ministries**

#### **DISTRIBUTORS**

On July 15, 2006, we launched two No Greater Joy Distributor Programs to give others an opportunity to purchase our material at heavily discounted prices. Thirty of them are located out of the US covering twelve countries. Many others now have the opportunity to purchase our material from individuals or businesses within their own country to avoid the high cost of shipping plus the long time delay in receiving their selections. It also allows for much more Ministry opportunity than we could possibly take care of ourselves.

#### **COMMERCIAL RIGHTS**

Dion Johnson is selling large amounts of our material so we have given him permission to print in South Africa and duplicate our CD's/DVD's. This allows him to have an end cost at considerable savings. He in turn pays us a small royalty on each item that was printed or duplicated. (See his testimony at the end of the article). We also have Rights Agreements in Korea, Poland, and India and pending Agreements in about twenty other countries.

#### **MINISTRY RIGHTS**

We receive many requests to translate our publications into other languages. As long as it is for Ministry we do not charge a royalty; it is the way we serve other Ministries. We qualify the individual or Ministry to make sure they have the capability to translate and take the final work to print before approving their request.

This is a quote from someone that wants to translate *Good and Evil* into several European languages. "I'm seriously interested on participating on this project, for its production for Central, East and South Europe, with focus predominantly on post-communist countries of this region where I have 4 decades long experiences".

#### **SPANISH**

One of our largest areas of growth is to the worldwide Hispanic marketplace. Within the past two months we have translated the *Good and Evil* Comics Volumes 3, 4 and 5 along with *Holy Sex*, *Jumping Ship*, and *Pornography Road To Hell* into Spanish.

We did this in anticipation of attending the Expolit Conference in Miami this past May. During the 5 day event we had numerous radio and TV interviews that went to Spanish speaking countries throughout the Caribbean plus countries in South America, Central America and North America. We had interest from businesses in ten countries. Columbia, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala, Mexico, Nicaragua, Puerto Rico, Peru, Portugal, and Spain as well as from several Hispanic churches in the U.S.

One of the hits of the show was the Spanish *Good and Evil* Color Comic. Many remarked about the overall quality of the comic, the illustrations and the vivid color schemes.

Many fathers purchased the comics in English and Spanish for the purpose of teaching their younger children how to read in both languages. Most impressive was the Scripture verses that corresponded to the illustrated Bible stories at the bottom of each page. In May we joined the Spanish Evangelical Publishers Association (SEPA) to assist us in reaching this growing market.

#### WHERE ARE WE GOING

To help us expand our worldwide presence, we have joined Christian Trade Association International (CTA). CTA is a nonprofit trade association committed to the growth of Christian trade worldwide. Their Market Directory has over 1,000 suppliers from 64 countries listed

rectory has over 1,000 suppliers from 64 countries listed. They have over 2,000 members in 20 countries. Over the past two years our international presence has increased over tenfold. We will be attending the International Christian Retail Show to reach out internationally as well as to the US Christian booksellers market.

Pray with us as we reach out to those throughout the world so that those overseas can be Blessed with the same material that has Blessed so many in our great country.

Since we started home-schooling I wanted to run some sort of family business. Something that we could do together that would prepare my kids for the real world and make learning more practical. I wasn't sure what it could be. I was self-employed but the nature of my work (computer programming) was not something that my kids could be involved with much. My kids were 8, 5 and 4 years old when we started distributing the Created To Be His Help Meet books in our neighbourhood. We bought some boxes of 24 and started to lend them out and sell them very cheaply. Word got out and the demand grew for these books. We did not want to make any profit out of selling the books because we saw it as pure ministry and did not want our profit to hinder the books being read. At that very time, No Greater Joy started to offer "Business-In-A-Box" and we realized that this was for us. Only problem was that we didn't have any money to buy it. My wife and I prayed and within a few days we had the money in cash!! That was all the encouragement we needed. We immediately applied and paid and within a few weeks we were proudly opening up our materials in our lounge/kitchen. We started training our kids with labelling and now (2 years later) they are far advanced. It has been a big

learning for us all, but the blessings have been fantastic. Running this business involves a large range of skills and opportunities to learn and develop. My 10 year old son is now basically running his own business of producing the DVDs and CDs himself (still under my supervision). Of course, receiving testimonies of marriages transformed throughout South Africa is another huge encouragement and we are even printing the "To Train Up A Child" books in South Africa now.
