

HAVE BEEN PREACHING T HAVE DELLY THE the good news of Jesus' love and forgiveness for the past 60 years. Deb and I have seen many people come to know Christ, watched them grow and get married, rejoiced in the birth of their children, taught their children, watched them grow to be adults and get married, and in a few cases now teach their children. That makes us spiritual great-grandparents to some kids. It has been a beautiful thing to see. But not all life stories end well. Some fell away after a while. Others floundered from one backsliding experience to another. Some recovered to live consistent Christian lives; others immersed themselves into the world and were swallowed by guilt, grief, and shame, their lives ruined.

The thing that most concerns me are the ones who professed to know Christ years ago, in many cases following their spouse's conversion experience, and continue to this day in a form of godliness that gives all appearances of being a real Christian; yet they have never shown a genuine love for God. They pray at the right times, ask God for his help, and feel rather secure. But if you ask them (and I have), "Are you sure that if you died right now you would go to heaven?" they often answer, "I hope so," or "I am not sure." They sometimes answer in the affirmative and then point to life choices that give them confidence that they must be a Christian. They say, "God answers my prayers, and he would not answer the prayers of a sinner." Or they might say, "I asked Jesus in my heart and was baptized; and I confess my sins." When challenged they will answer, "I tell God that if I am not saved, I want to be; surely he would not turn me away."

Thankfully, from time to time I have seen adults confess that they are lost sinners, without hope before God, admitting they have lived a lie all these years, whereupon they enter into a confident faith relationship with Jesus Christ and become abundant-life Christians.

Observing many experiences over a span of 65 years has taught us to recognize fake Christians—pretenders

along for the ride, accommodating their spouses, enjoying the fellow-ship of Christians, professing what they have never actually experienced. We make no claim to infallible discernment; experience has also taught us that we can be wrong. A doctor diagnoses a patient and prescribes a remedy. Sometimes he is wrong, but the need for diagnosis continues. Just as there is a checklist of symptoms for different diseases, we have observed certain symptoms manifested by fake Christians.

- False converts avoid conversations about the Lord Jesus Christ. They will change the subject or make some judgment about another that diverts attention.
- 2. They **enjoy faulting others** and feel a sense of relief when others prove to be hypocrites. Gossip gives them peace.
- 3. They will usually **go to church at the prescribed hour** but avoid going to intense spiritual gatherings if they can do so without being singled out as disinterested.
- 4. False converts **do not have a burning desire to win others to Christ**. They can spend time with a lost friend or relative without feeling a compelling need to pray, share Christ, and lead them to saving faith.
- 5. In their secret thought life **they do not dream of going to heaven** and meeting the Savior face to face. If they are somehow forced to think about it, they do so with discomfort and lack of assurance.
- 6. They **do not have a desire to read the Word of God** and learn more about their God and Savior.
- 7. Their **prayer life tends to be formal and regulated**, not spontaneous and believing.
- 8. They **do not have a life of private worship**, praise, and thanksgiving. They just do not love the very thought of God.
- 9. In some cases, though not all, the false convert is known to live on the edge of worldliness. They secretly yearn for a more liberal, worldly lifestyle, but the Christian culture constrains them to walk a narrower path for reasons of self-interest.

- 10. Others go to the opposite extreme: rather than flirt with worldliness, they are **prominently pious**, **known to flaunt their personal convictions**. They are known for exalting single issues like head coverings, women wearing pants, birth control, and affiliation with a particular denomination. Their zeal is a substitute for worship and love.
- 11. When worldly minded false converts find themselves removed from the Christian culture and influence, as in the case of divorce, moving to a different location, suddenly coming into wealth with new friends, opportunities, and means, they find it easy to enjoy worldliness, feeling liberated for the first time.
- 12. This list of thirteen signs of being a false convert **leaves them feeling uncomfortable or critical of this article**. Their tendency is not to share it with people they feel might be false converts, but to put it away and forget about it. "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again" (John 3:7).
- 13. Their pride will not allow them to admit that they are lost sinners. Their reputation means more to them than actually being saved.

Sadly, even now I have friends and family members whom I believe have never been born again. They are good people but fake Christians. Some whom I have known for many years have associated with true converts, undetected.

Jesus had just twelve disciples and one of them was a fake Christian. For three and a half years Judas tried to believe. He gave up a lot to follow Christ. He performed miracles, cast out devils, preached the gospel of the kingdom of heaven, and ministered in such a manner that when Jesus announced that one of them would betray him, none suspected it was Judas. Clearly Judas did not spend those several years knowingly pretending to be something he was not. Only a sincere commitment to the cause of Christ would have sustained him for three years. There may have been times when his thieving nature

took over and he stole a little here and there. Like most thieves, he doubtlessly excused himself with a noble motive of why he needed the money. "As he thinketh in his heart, so is he" (Proverbs 23:7).

It was not until Jesus announced he was going to be taken and crucified that Judas decided he could make a little profit on the side. Judas was a conniver, telling half-truths, appearing to be sacrificing, and when he helped himself to the purse he always gave some of the money in order to maintain his "good Christian" identity. Remember how he reacted when Mary broke the alabaster box of expensive oil on Jesus' feet? Judas said, "We could have sold that and used the money to feed a lot of poor people." He knew he could make a little money on the side and still feed a lot of poor folks. When he saw the opportunity to make a profit off Jesus, he was careful. He enjoyed the good favor and camaraderie of the other disciples, and thus made sure that they would not suspect him, so he chose to betray Jesus with a kiss. After seeing Jesus' miracles, Judas would have assumed Jesus would not be in any real trouble if the authorities took him. We know this because of his shock when Judas saw the results of his betrayal.

Judas was deeply sorry for his actions and changed his mind—repented—seeking to reverse course. He returned the money to the temple priests and confessed his sin. He could have confessed his sin to Jesus and the disciples, but he didn't want them to know who and what he was. Nevertheless, his guilt would not abate, so

he committed suicide, going straight to hell where he is suffering at this very hour, two thousand years later.

In his heart Judas was never a Christian; he was an ordinary religious man, seeking to fulfill his spiritual impulses, making a great effort to please God but never loving God with all his heart, soul, mind, body, and strength. He was a false convert. It just took three and a half years to manifest.

In my experience, 95% of those who identify with the Christian religion have never been born again. When we go to meetings with hundreds or thousands of people, we are aware that large numbers of the parents are not real Christians, and most of the kids are not. They want to be. They call themselves a Christian family, but many are false converts. I know that to be the case by the large number who write letters or come up to us and share how after years of pretending to be a Christian, they finally believed the gospel and were saved.

I do not write this to condemn you but to warn you. You know your own heart and mind. God is patiently calling your name. Someday soon it will be too late.

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

BUT WHY DID JESUS HAVE TO TAKE OUR SIN ON HIMSELF BEFORE HE COULD FORGIVE US?



Christ was first given 39 lashes from a "cat-o'-nine-tails" (a whip with nine leather straps, each bearing a cutting instrument at the end) providing a potential of 351 lacerations. He was blindfolded and beaten beyond recognition. They pulled out his beard and placed a crown of thorns on his head. With mocking hostility, the religious in the crowd spit into the blood that streamed down his face.

As he stood in silence, the greatest pain was not the thorns scratching his skull or the flesh dangling from his back; **it was the shame of our sin.**

HE TOOK YOUR PLACE

All sins of all persons, past and future, were laid on Christ. He bore them so intimately, the Bible says he became sin. He "despised the shame", but for our salvation, he "endured the cross." Imagine! The most **pure** and holy taking the place of the most **impure** and unholy!

"He (God) hath made him (Jesus) to be sin for us..." 2 Corinthians 5:21

"Who his own self *bare our sins* in his own body on the tree..." 1 Peter 2:24

"The LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all." Isaiah 53:6

The righteousness you receive is not gained by anything you do; it is the gift of what God has done for you.


DO YOU BELIEVE THIS GOOD NEWS?

IMPORTANT THINGS

to Know in Raising Children

1. Make time for them.

Children are like plants. They need attention and direction every day.

I plant a garden every year, and about half of the time I wait too long to stake my tomatoes. A small plant doesn't need staking; I tell myself I will stake them before it becomes critical. But it may rain for an entire week, or I get busy doing something else and can't get around to it. Then the plant gets so big the stems bend and fall on the ground. When the leaves of a tomato plant are exposed

to the soil, they quickly develop disease. When the fruit touches the ground, it will rot about the time it should be getting ripe. You don't realize you are losing your crop until it is too late. This year I had a second late patch that I intended to stake but again waited too long. I finally staked them but too late to prevent the loss.

It is not what I did; it is what I didn't do that spoiled the crop. So it is with children. They need constant pruning and fertilizing and training to grow up instead of down—to reach for blue skies instead of withering

on the ground. Raising children is an in-season and out-of-season job. You can't just allow nature to take its course. Children need the constant sunshine of their parents' smiles and approval. They need to be pointed in the right direction day after day. They need admonition like a plant needs fertilizer. And as water activates the fertilizer making it available to the roots, smiles activate our admonition making it available to the child's soul. Children raised right grow up right—no exceptions. It is God's certain promise (Proverbs 22:6).

Children need the constant sunshine of their parents' smiles and approval.

2. Set a good example.

Every parent needs to understand this: more is caught than taught. Instilling thankfulness in a child is done by example and training. When children's souls are full of thankfulness, they don't grow up being irritated or hurt because someone mistreated them. Thankfulness goes a long way in child training.

Honesty is of key importance. Children see when a parent is a little dishonest in the way they handle money, and it can be very destructive to their souls. Much of the book of Proverbs is written to admonish people to deal honestly and uprightly with all people. God cannot bless your family if you are cunning in your dealings with others.

The good example extends to every area of life. Any discipline you want your children to have you must exemplify yourself. Be what you want your children to be and you will be providing the best training possible.

3. Express encouragement rather than displeasure.

This is a biggie. I have observed parents relating to their children in intermittent displeasure and seen the negative effect it has. When they ask my advice, I have pointed out their destructive tendency to always criticize or show displeasure with their child. They are usually shocked and unbelieving. "I love my children," they exclaim. And I respond, "But?" They fill in the blank: "But he is so stubborn and willful, always doing the opposite of what I tell him." And with exasperation and what I detect as anger, they say, "I have spanked him and it seems to do no good; I just don't know what to do any more." I follow up with, "You say he is stubborn most of the time, so how do you respond most of the time?"

In Debi's book, Create a Better Brain through Neuroplasticity: A Manual for Mamas, she shows how brain scans are revealing that parents can actually groove their child's brain to think in such a way that the child will want to do good. It is important not to get into the negative habit toward your child. This can become a vicious cycle that is patterning the brain for an automatic response. I have

said many times, if you cannot train your children to do as they ought, it is far better to lower your standards and enjoy them as they are than to allow your looks of displeasure to become the norm.

A vital part of stopping the bad behavior is to cease the cycle of looks of rejection and begin to look for ways to encourage and show appreciation.

I have spoken of it elsewhere, especially in my DVDs, The Joy of Training, and the article, The Flavor of Joy (found in the back of To Train *Up a Child*), so I will not go into detail here, but suffice it to say child training is causing the child to want to please you and be like you. Children will want to please you only when they find pleasure in your presence. You must become the vital source of their joy if they are going to give up their rebellion and choose to exercise self-discipline and self-denial. Training a child to be a good human does not save their soul before God, but it

does make it easier for them not to be caught up in the world before they can come to a knowledge of where they stand before God.

4. Set boundaries.

Enforcing boundaries builds security and responsibility in children. This takes diligence. It is much easier to not enforce boundaries. It is a mistake to just love your kids and believe they will turn out okay as long as you do not create any self-loathing or feelings of rejection like we talked about above. It is naive to just smile and believe in the innate goodness of their sweet little hearts, and trust that someday they will grow up and take responsibility for their actions.

It is easy to avoid enforcing boundaries because it is the path of least resistance. You don't have to stir yourself or upset the kids. Let them do as they please—free expression, you know—and they will become your average reprobates.

If children all came into the world disciplined and wise and willing to deny their impulses for the greater good, we could just leave them to free expression, but every parent knows better. All children come to us innocent but fallen. They are hedonistic, self-indulging hippies in their natural state. Left to themselves they will bring their mothers to shame (Proverbs 29:15).

Adults are supposed to be mature enough to choose the virtuous path and do what they ought to do even if it is contrary to their desires. That is character—something that no

one is born with and that has to be developed. Training children to respect boundaries will build character. Small children do not see the need for self-denial or self-restraint. They feel desire and they do what feels good. Therefore, parents must constrain young children to right behavior. In time their moral understanding will develop and they will begin to choose good, even when it is contrary to their carnal desires. Character is formed, and as training continues, their character grows stronger as they mature into adults.

5. Choose friends, activities and churches carefully.

Many parents have done a good job in training their young children and have put them on a path of virtue, but in their early teens they are influenced by their peers and yield to temptation while knowing it is not the right path. Even well-trained children are flesh and are capable of falling into sin—just as is a moral, disciplined adult. In Debi's book, Create a Better Brain through Neuroplasticity, she teaches how the prefrontal cortex, the area of the brain where wise decision making is established, is not yet fully developed until a person is about 25 years old. Before this time, all young people use the area of the

brain called the amygdala to make decisions. The amygdala is referred to by scientists as the seat of emotion. No wonder kids are not wise! They do not have the brain yet to understand the consequences of wrong choices. They need guidance and oversight until roughly 25 years old. Not until several years after kids graduate from college are they wise enough to discern good from evil. If you disagree with that assessment, explain spring break at the beach or fraternity initiations. Whoa!

It all starts very young. You must choose the social circle for your children and guard it. The quickest way to throw your small children away is to enroll them in daycare or preschool or first grade. You lose all control over their friends and they become part of the social pool, eventually reduced to the lowest common denominator. If your child shares a pool with kids where just one of them has pooped in the water, your kid is swimming in poop. A few good kids don't keep the water clean, but one bad kid pollutes it for everybody. I cannot remember the good kids in my third grade, but there were a couple bad ones I will never forget. I can remember their foul words and deeds to this day.

This is probably the hardest thing for a parent to do. It requires great effort and constant vigilance to sift your social circle. There will be times your kids will not understand, and there will be times other parents are offended, but a mother hen guards her chicks against the foxes and coyotes, regardless. To protect your kids may require an adjustment to your lifestyle. A chicken that has roosted under a chicken hawk

nest needs to move, even if it is inconvenient. If your church is full of public school kids, you will need to keep your children at your side all the time and not allow them to get personal with the other children. It becomes impossible to limit the social contact of a teenager in such an environment. They shouldn't have the burden of constantly choosing or eliminating people from their acquaintance; that is your job. Find a social circle that is righteous and productive where you have nothing to fear from 25 of the teenagers getting together to play soccer or go roller skating together.

You must **choose** the social circle for your children and **guard it.**

Remember, at some point they will transition from you providing their complete social circle to choosing for themselves. You cannot control them past the age when they grow to be autonomous, so you must train them to wisely choose their friends. For the time will come when what you say has little bearing.

6. Being Accountable.

Responsible action is the duty of all people, and accountability is the inevitable result of being part of a society where the principle of cause and effect is well understood. When there are two people in a room, insofar as they can have an effect on each other, each is responsible for his actions, and the law of love makes us responsible for our neighbor's well-being. "Let no

man seek his own [to advance self], but every man another's wealth" (1 Corinthians 10:24). Seek to advance the wealth of your neighbor.

You should give your children responsibility according to their ability. A child who can walk should be held responsible to pick up his dirty clothes and put them in the laundry basket, clean up spills, and place his toys and books back where they belong. This is the foundation of all future responsible actions.

I have observed a beautiful principle: the children most accountable to act responsibly are the happiest and most secure in love and grounded in goodwill. You learn to love your neighbor one act of caring at a time.

7. Beware the greatest evil of all.

Today's world is different from any other. It is difficult in our world "to train up a child in the way he should go," and some very good and sincere people fail, not for want of personal righteousness and not for want of trying. Over the years we have watched our culture change as we listen to the weeping of parents sitting in front of us as we counsel. Children are being exposed to some of the most horrific evil imaginable while they sit on their couch with their parents. The cell phone is the devil's favorite toy. It is Satan's direct line to most every child. In the next article you will read just how prevalent the wickedness has become. You can do all to raise a happy, obedient child that comes to know the Lord at an early age, then

lose them in one afternoon as they play with another child and view men doing things to very little children that are too gross, evil, and demonic to speak of. I despair for the parents of this generation. More than ever before, I exhort you:

Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;" Ephesians 6:11–18 ■

Required READING

I read an article yesterday that should be required reading for every parent. It was written by a young mom, Sloane (not her real name). She works with an organization called Bark, whose sole purpose is to protect children from online predators. Her story is chilling.

In the article she recounts a typical day in her work with Bark. They start with a photo of Sloane wearing clothing a pre-teen would wear, glitter nail polish, chest bound with ace bandages. Team members use photo manipulation to turn it into a perky and innocent 11-year-old girl they call Bailey who, at that age, should be playing house and having tea parties.

Sloane uses an iPhone paired to a big-screen TV so the whole team can follow along. A video camera records it all because every speck of evidence is precious to law enforcement. The team creates accounts of fictitious young girls to show parents how pervasive the problem of online predation is.

Tonight Sloane is 11-year-old Bailey. She uploads a "selfie" to Instagram and writes a caption about being excited to see her friends tonight. Then she waits.

Sloane writes: "This part never takes long. It's always unnervingly



fast... on the very first night as Bailey, two new messages came in under a minute after publishing a photo... the numbers pinged up on the screen—2, 3, 7, 15 messages from adult men over the course of two hours. Half of them could be charged with transfer of obscene content to a minor."

She goes on to describe in hideously graphic detail the conversations these men have with what they think is a little girl.

Are you hearing this, Mama? Are you paying attention, Daddy? In just two hours of an innocuous photo on Instagram, sick, twisted perverts are sending your innocent little girl pornographic photos of themselves and asking her to participate in activities too horrific to imagine.

Where are you while this is happening? Are you driving while she sits in the back seat and has her mind forever polluted by the filth of the world? Are you watching TV in the living room while she lies on her bed enjoying a little social media time with her "friends"?

It is not innocent or harmless entertainment. It is you standing at the door of your child's mind and heart and actively inviting the devil in. It is not enough to put a filter on the Internet in your home. Your children have access to the Web everywhere they go. Their friends have cell phones with unfiltered Internet. Some girls are "groomed" through their school email accounts.

And it's pervasive: social media, Fortnite and Minecraft, TikTok, and chat apps. Small children are targeted while watching My Little Pony videos on YouTube and playing games designed for very young children. Literally any time your child is on the Internet, he or she is a potential victim.

Last year, in a sting operation at the Jersey shore in which they posed as children online, authorities arrested 24 predators in the first week. In another county, 17. In another, 19. Those arrested came from all walks of life—"a police officer, a teacher, a minister, a nurse, a bank manager, a mechanic, a waiter, a dental hygienist, a college student…" There is no "typical predator" profile.

A state deputy attorney general said, "Nearly every game has a chat, so it's hard for parents to keep track, even if they're doing their homework." Did you hear that? You can't keep up.

Do you feel paranoid? You should. You are no match for the devil's world. So what is a parent to do in this age of high-tech?

Say no. No, you will not have a cell phone or a tablet or computer of your

own. You will not have a school email account (all necessary emails can be sent to the parents). You will not sleep over at your friend's house. Your friend may not bring her cell phone here. You will not ride the bus to school.

Will that be enough? Will she be protected if we just homeschool and home church and don't let her have a cell phone?

Sadly, no. So much of life in the 21st century is technologically driven, and it is becoming exponentially more so every day. Eventually the children will leave home for work or school. It is not enough to shield them from the dangers that are out there; we must teach them to guard their own hearts. Train them to be vigilant gate-keepers of their own minds so that when the first glimmer of temptation shows up, they are so well trained they instinctively flee. We must insulate them from within, as Mike wrote in this article 18 years ago ngj.org/insulate.

Parenting in 2020 is much scarier than it was when my children were little in the 1980s. The dangers are more pervasive than ever, but Ecclesiastes says, "there is no new thing under the sun." The devil who wanted my kids in 1980 still wants yours today; he's just keeping up with technology better than you are.
