



uestion from a Father:
I have raised three girls
and they all turned out well.
My last child is a boy who
has just turned fourteen. I
am seeing signs of trouble
and need some advice. I

don't think I know how to raise a boy. He is unhappy with his circumstances in life. He feels that I am depriving him of friends and opportunities to experience life. He wants a cell phone


so he can share with others on social media. He wants to "hang out" with guys that I do not have confidence share our vision for our son. My greatest concern is that it seems I do not have his respect. We are really not friends. I feel like he thinks I am an impediment to his happiness. What can I do?

Michael Answers:

If by "do" you mean some overlooked parenting technique, I must tell you there is nothing to "do." Your child and the dynamics of your

relationship are so much more complex than to be solved by the addition of some single corrective act. Think about it. If you came to me with marriage difficulty and asked for something you could "do" to cause your wife to suddenly respect and like you, and drop all her grievances, would you expect it to be as simple as roses once a week or a sit-down talk? Marriage is a relationship built on many hours and many experiences. Healing requires a fundamental change in the soul of one or both individuals. Likewise, the raising of a child is a complex relationship, even more complex than marriage due to changing hormones. It is a good thing that there are only about four or five years before a post-pubertal child is weaned from his parents as a young adult, no longer under family mandates. If the relationship that exists from thirteen to eighteen years of age lasted twenty



years instead of five, 95% of kids would soon divorce their parents. It is the sure knowledge that their servitude will be over in just a few years that gives hope to disgruntled teenagers.

Yeah, I know, this sounds dark and hopeless. Yet there is a way. But it comes at a price higher than most parents are willing to pay, for in many cases it requires a change of heart and a change of lifestyle—maybe a change of occupation and the community in which you live.

I look around at families I have known and observed since the parents were teenagers or younger, their children now grown and married or of marriageable age, and I see mixed results. Some are dismal

failures and others are a delight to God—an expression of heaven. I can see the root causes of successes or failures, and it is not as most would think. On one extreme, I know parents who smoked tobacco and pot and drank moderately who were nonetheless a raging success as parents—be sure, a very limited number indeed. And on the other end of the scale, I know parents who were strict, teaching their children to quote large portions of the Bible, never watching any media or mixing

with sinners. Everyone dressed modestly and said, "please" and "thank you" and "yes ma'am" and "no sir," and at the first opportunity some of their children went the way of world, wanting nothing to do with God today. I see the difference. I

know the causes and effects.

In most cases success is not due to any forethought or deliberation by the parents; they just pass on their hearts and temperament in a natural context incidentally suited to raising good kids. It's the "old paths"—what average Christian, rural families were seventy-five years ago. Our society is no longer Christian and no longer natural. Community is not natural. Family is not natural. Education is not natural. And child training is not natural. There are still small pockets where young men and women come to marriage bringing with them a relaxed worldview and lifestyle that will result in good kids, but every year that circle becomes exponentially smaller.


In an age where the old paths are mostly forgotten, it takes careful planning and deliberate, patient execution to guarantee success in raising children. If you didn't inherit

a lifestyle, community, temperament, and worldview that are conducive to raising good kids, you must make the sacrifices necessary to reestablish a working form of the old paths.

What are the old paths of which I speak, and how can you reclaim a culture you never experienced or inherited? I will recount the common characteristic I have observed in successful families.

A family that works together stays together. A family that strives together thrives together. A family that is a working team, striving toward a common goal, will engender loyalty in their children. Things like feeding the animals, collecting eggs, butchering chickens so you will have meat on the table after church on Sunday, repairing the barn, or adding on a bedroom so the kids can spread out are examples. Taking the boys to work where they learn a trade is invaluable. Even the girls feel better about themselves when they have operated a weed eater, bringing in money to enhance the quality of life for the whole family.

The child who is not needed as part of the team will gravitate toward loyalties outside the family. Participation cannot be staged or fabricated. It must be real. The child who is not truly needed for the survival and well-being of the family will not develop holy pride

and righteous ambition. He will turn to video games, social media, and friends who just "hang" together, talking about how the world "sucks."

Back to the letter that prompted this discussion: You say you raised three good girls. But boys are quite different from girls in what satisfies their aspirations. Boy have a greater need to explore, invent, achieve something objective, conquer, and compete. They have a need to be meaningfully engaged in pursuits that yield objective results, like

rebuilding automobiles, painting a house, cutting firewood, building something that others will admire. They are little kings looking to build a kingdom and furnish it. Idleness (including entertainment) breeds self-loathing and wanderlust.


If you are not skilled in the "manly" arts, there are alternate ways to provide expression for your boys. It is subpar but better than nothing. You can loan them out to Christian friends who are active in welding, mechanics, farming, construction, lawn care, building of any kind, etc. The problem with letting someone else apprentice them is that they will bond with and respect the other man instead of you. But, again, it is far better than video games, social media, and "hanging out."

If you are a city slicker with a business or job that prevents your children from participating, there is an effective alternative to physically working together to achieve daily sustenance. Families that minister together and see positive results in the lives of others will raise delightful kids. When daily life is filled with prayer, counseling, teaching, and assisting others less fortunate, the children will grow up totally satisfied. But beware— Pharisaical, religious business will drive them away. Children are usually uncorrupted psychologists who see through religious pretense.

It is the satisfaction of achieving and conquering together that satisfies the soul of the child. The struggle to maintain shelter and food, as would be the case with an indigenous farmer, is the most natural context, but not everyone can do that. I have seen very wealthy families maintain

the loyalty and respect of their children because they sit around the dinner table and share their vision for expansion of the business, involving the children in the enterprise. At the earliest ages, the children are given jobs to do at the office that are meaningful. Projects at home focus on the children rising to challenges. A new pool and garden can be planned by the children and they can help the workmen. One wealthy father told me that in contracting out some remodeling, he told the carefully selected bidders that their

bids should include apprenticing his two boys. They were to work alongside the crew every day for the entire six months. Mother can arrange for the children to work at a local shelter or to teach Good News Clubs through Child Evangelism Fellowship. The family can "adopt" several widowed grandmothers and make weekly visits to assist them, even painting their dilapidated home and taking them shopping.

A busy life that is filled with productivity on the behalf of others produces a satisfied soul. An empty life of self-indulgence becomes boring and agitates the soul to seek satisfaction and excitement in carnal pursuits and worldly friends equally empty of heart and mind.

Self-respect is achieved the same way and for the same reason we respect others. It is based on integrity, hard work, sacrifice for others, expressions of compassion and mercy, justice, etc. When children act worthy they will feel worthy. Positive affirmation is only

useful when it is in recognition of a job well done.


As you can see, the answer to the question is simple but not an easy, quick fix. I said it may require a complete change of lifestyle.

Most parents are so wed to their social circle, church, vocation, and comfort zone that they will not take my advice. You will not want your daughters to marry their sons or vice versa. But there is no way to mold a child into the image of Christ if they are allowed to grow up in a different mold.

You, Father, are the head of the house. Raise your children in Sodom and you will have results no better than Lot. Build your house on a rock and the children will survive the storm.

There are other factors that are critical to raising good kids, some of which I have discussed in other articles and books, particularly Strong in Spirit. Space does not allow a thorough treatise of our subject—though what I have said here is universal and fundamental. Maybe in the next magazine I will expand upon it.

Having a life of joy and thanksgiving is the most powerful child-training tool because it naturally provokes a child to want to have and be what he values.





You can give a child the best education, provide many extra activities such as sports or music, pour your life into creating "quality time," and make available every good thing money can buy, but still have a discontented kid. There is a basic need in all humans that most parents wrongly assume children lack. ALL people—young and old, male and female have a natural need to be productive. Innate in all of us is the deep need to create, build, heal others, personally help those in need, and do something that has lasting merit. A child who is not put in a position to be genuinely needed for his contribution to the family will feel his lack of worth. This feeling will lead to either discontentment, self-destructive acts, rebellion (because he will blame you for his feeling of failure), and/or depression. This is why "school as usual" can be so counterproductive. Children need to be learning real-life skills with which to serve others.

Your job as a parent

is to find a way for your child to fulfill his God-given drive to be a giver.

Deb's bucket list. She never imagined it and now assures me she will never let this happen to her again. Once was more than enough.

a problem until this particular day. When I swung open the big door to the hen house, I was met with a blast of hot air. There were no chickens in the house since it was too hot. I was really glad because they are so pesky friendly. Nathan's kids raised these fowl, and the crazy chickens think they are pets. The fowl actually LIKE to be carried around and caressed. I had just bent down into the drum to scoop out the corn when that crazy hopping dog slammed the huge heavy door shut. I didn't panic. But I did scream, yell, and beat on the metal wall, which only attracted the attention of the fowl. They all rushed through the tiny opening on the floor to welcome me to their home. I still didn't panic, although the small, dim, hot room full of loudly squawking fowl was FOUL. I bent down

house due to me taking up their door rushed out while I was still on all fours but I WAS FREE.


Everyone at the table seemed frozen in time when I marched laughing into the kitchen, smelling and looking like poop. Those guests have a whole different perspective of me than most folks.

y little buddy Jeremiah, now 12 years old, has been by my side most of the week, helping in significant ways. Just yesterday we were cleaning up the shop (he loves to organize things), and his job was sorting the many wrenches, sockets, and ratchets. For you mechanically illiterate dummies, those are the tools used to work on automobiles and the like. When I told Jeremiah to put the metric tools in one drawer and the standard in another, he inquired as to why they made two different kinds. Now, at the time I didn't think of it as homeschooling, but later in the evening as I was telling Deb about it, she observed that it was a quality learning experience for a 12-year-old.

LIFESTYLE Homeschooling

I explained to Jeremiah that throughout history different people groups developed their own methods of measurement. The US adopted the British method of feet and inches. Most of the rest of the world uses the metric system. The discussion moved to 24-hour days. And then we talked about why the circle and the earth itself are divided into 360 degrees, and each degree is divided into 60 minutes, and each minute into 60 seconds. Navigation universally employs degrees, minutes, and seconds.

Twelve inches makes a foot, denoting the length of the average man's foot. Feet and inches, yards and acres are derived from the English. A yard is the distance from the end of the king's nose to his thumb on his outstretched arm (must have been a tall king). A yard (36 inches) is the average girth of a man around the waist—my own belt size. A yard is also

the length of stride of an Englishman walking briskly.

Wanting to know more about the 360-degree circle, we later resorted to Google. Not long after creation, earliest man in the Mesopotamian valley (modern Iraq, in the area that comprised the Garden in Eden) observed the annual track of the sun and the 30-day lunar cycle and assigned 360 days to a year (twelve months of 30 days each). Subsequently, the circle of the earth was divided into 360 days or degrees. Yes, they were aware that there were 3651/4 days in a year (365.2422 to be exact), but they chose to round it off to be consistent with geometry as did the Hebrews later on, adding a thirteenth month when necessary to keep the seasons consistent.

After the Tower of Babel dispersed men into different languages and people groups, those who would come



to be known as Egyptians employed the 360-degree division of a circle in their geometry. The Egyptians built with many triangles—the pyramid for example. As any kid with a compass will discover, the Egyptians were aware that six triangular slices of 60 degrees each equal a complete circle of 360 degrees. No doubt, when time was first recorded on a sun dial (a circle), it made sense to divide hours into 60 minutes and minutes into 60 seconds. So we can see that the 360-degree circle is suggested by physics itself, and the division of each degree into minutes and seconds (a second being the average heart beat and the most restful rhythm for music) are suggested by nature itself.

However, I could not tell Jeremiah the origin of the metric system, so we looked that up too. Together, we learned that the Chinese, Arabs, and Hindus each had their own measuring system. In the 17th century, the French developed the metric system to be more compatible with math and

equations. Calculations in the metric system can be performed simply by shifting the decimal point. Thus, the metric system is a decimal (base 10) system. The length of a meter was derived by calculating one tenmillionth of the distance between the equator and the North Pole, which comes to exactly 39.37 inches. Anyone who has ever tried to use a calculator, or pencil and paper, to compute feet and inches has run into a wall of difficulty that is best resolved by resorting to the more convenient metric system.

Jeremiah and I learned together. That is the way my sons and daughters were homeschooled. They spent a little time in a classroom setting when they were four to eight years old, but by the time they could work outside, most of their education came from life experiences and inquisitive minds. Today our five children are between the ages of 33 and 43. They are able to discuss most any subject with most any professional on most any topic. This

time next year that "most any topic" will be larger, as they all continue to learn. The advantage of lifestyle homeschooling is that you never graduate. It becomes a way of life. Every year advances you to a higher grade.

I cannot overemphasize the broad value of learning with your kids and grandkids. You are never an old fogey if you are learning. You remain interesting to the kids, and you become their favorite source of knowledge and wisdom. We might call this "tying strings of education."

You can't be too ignorant to homeschool. It is not how much you know; it is how much you are learning. You don't need to communicate great things; you just need to communicate the joy of learning. Don't stand off at a distance while your children pencil in the answers to irrelevant questions, bored to death, looking forward to the day they can cease schooling. Make education a lifestyle the whole family shares.



Of over 150,000 views this year, up to a third revisited the site at least once to continuing learning the Bible story. The language most accessed this year was Arabic. While American Christians are hiding to

view porn, Muslims are sneaking around and viewing the Jesus story. The average age is 13–18, the best age to reach them. It is worthy to note: they were viewing it in black and white. Just think how many more return views we would have gotten if it were in color! It costs us about \$1,000.00 each to convert a single language to color. We are engaged in that process right now.

In the remote regions of Mongolia, over 23,000 viewed G&E in their language.

You read about Pakistan in the news. Wouldn't it be great to take



the gospel into the mountains where the terrorists hide out? We did. Over 11,000 Pakistanis accessed G&E this year—in Arabic.

We wondered why a country of 6.5 million Muslims would have nearly 50,000 views. One young man decided to place an openended Facebook ad through our program, iMissionaries. For less than five dollars a day he provoked thousands of Muslims to read the good news of Jesus Christ. He had over 600,000 actions in Arabic, with over 75,000 opening

GoodandEvilbook.com. We had no idea how effective iMissionaries is! We plan to do a lot more advertising this year.

We want to take the extraordinary possibilities of this ministry and expand them 10-fold. Would you partner with us? Every dollar spent will reach 3 people in the Arab world.
